GENERAL INFORMATION

ENTRY FEES

Entry fees will be in Canadian funds. Payments can be made by cash, cheque (payable to the BCTA), or debit card. Credit cards are NOT accepted. Entry fees or options for an event will not be refunded after that event has started.

SQUADDING

Pre-squadding is available at Presquad.com for free. Pre-squadding will close on Wednesday, May 15th, 2024 at midnight.

Shoot management reserves the right to move shooter(s) to a different squad in order to avoid unnecessary delay during the shoot. Any squad with one or two shooters may be required to shoot at the start/end of the event. One or two shooter squads will also be assigned a referee.

PAL / LICENSE REQUIREMENT

All shooters must be in possession of a valid Canadian firearms licence. Non-licence Junior shooters may be allowed to shoot under supervision of a licence holder subject to BCTA and host club approval. For non-Canadian shooters, a valid non-resident firearm declaration form is the equivalent of a Canadian firearms licence and can be obtained at the Canada Border Services Agency upon entry into Canada for a fee of \$25.00.

REGISTRATION

Registration opens on Thursday at NOTSC at 3:00 PM, then at 7:00am on Fri, and 8:00am Sat, Sun & Mon.

All Contestants must be members of the PITA for the current year. Annual membership fee is \$25.00 CAD (first time PITA memberships & Junior memberships are \$12.50).

CROSS REGISTRATION

ATA Cross Registration will NOT be available at this event.

EARNED YARDAGE

If you earn yardage during the shoot, please check-in with the cashier as you may need to move to a different squad.

SHOOT-OFFS

All ties from Event 1, 2 and 3 will be determined by carry-over at Event 4, 6, and 7. Championship event ties (Event 4-5, 7, 8) will be decided by shoot-offs which will be held after the last event of the day. It is the shooters responsibility to be aware of any shoot-off. Contestants who miss their shoot-off will forfeit



GENERAL INFORMATION

ROOKIE OF THE YEAR

All new British Columbia shooters who have not shot any PITA or ATA registered targets on or before last year's BCTA Provincial Shoot are eligible to compete for this category.

Eligible contestants must shoot the BC Singles Championship (Ev. 4 & 5) and BC Handicap Championship (Ev. 8) for a total of 300 targets to qualify.

The winner will be awarded a trophy and will be eligible to represent our Province at the Grand Pacific in 2024 in the 2024 PITA ROOKIE OF THE YEAR competition. In the absence of the winner, the runner up may compete.

TARGET SETTING

A target setting committee appointed by the Executive Committee will set targets each morning according to PITA rules. Target setting changes will be made during an event only if the targets become illegal. Resetting of targets must be authorized and checked only by a member of the target setting committee. No exceptions.

SPECIAL HIDDEN SCORE

Available on Handicap Events # 2, 6 & 8

Shooters who bought this option will have their scores placed into a random draw. If there are multiple shooters with the same score, duplicate entries will be entered into the draw. One score will then be drawn to determine the Special Hidden Score. Prize money will be split among shooters shooting the same winning score, if applicable.

FORD PURSE

Available on Handicap Events # 2, 6, 8

Ford Purse sequence is 100-25-25-25-50-50-50. Limit of 3 Ford twinning purses per shooter. Ties on 25's and 50's will be decided by carry forward and/or reverse scoring. If a winner is still not decided, the purse will be divided equally among the shooters. Ties on the 100 purse will be automatically divided.

BC CAP CHALLENGE RULES FREE ENTRY - CASH PURSE: \$1500

The BC Cap Challenge will be held during the Preliminary (Friday) Handicap, all entrants of this event qualify.



BC 'CAP CHALLENGE

The top 5 scores from each Zone (Island Zone, Mainland Zone, Interior Zone, North Country Zone and, if enough in attendance, Out of Province), will determine the teams.

Out of Province must have a minimum of 5 OoP shooters to qualify for a team.

Provincial Zone(s) with less than 5 shooters entered will merge as Team BC.

If Team BC does not have 5 shooters, the remaining team members will be chosen from shooters that did not make their respective Zone Team (the next highest score after team selection).

The team with the highest combined score will be declared the BC Cap Challenge Champions and reserve all bragging rights associated with the title.

The winning team will split the BC Cap Challenge Purse evenly.

Ties for team member selection and/or the BC Cap Challenge purse will be determined by carry-over in the Memorial Handicap (Sunday).

Carry-overs will be based on each sub event (25 targets) and continue until all ties are broken.

Ties existing after the completion of the Memorial Handicap Championship will be determined by a shoot-off until a winning team is determined.

The BC Cap Challenge Committee will oversee the BC Cap Challenge. All decisions are final.
