GENERAL INFORMATION

ENTRY FEES

Entry fees will be in Canadian funds. Payments can be made by cash, cheque (payable to the BCTA), Debit cards, or Interac E-Transfer (send to: shootbc-ta@gmail.com). **Credit cards are NOT accepted**. Entry fees or options for an event will not be refunded after that event has started.

SQUADDING

Pre-squadding is available at **Presquad.com** for free. Pre-squadding will close on Wednesday, August 11th, 2021 at midnight.

Shoot management reserves the right to move shooter(s) to a different squad in order to avoid unnecessary delay during the shoot. Any squad with one or two shooters may be required to shoot at the start/end of the event. One or two shooter squads will also be assigned a referee.

PAL / LICENSE REQUIREMENT

All shooters must be in possession of a valid Canadian firearms licence.

For non-Canadian shooters, a valid non-resident firearm declaration form is the equivalent of a Canadian firearms licence and can be obtained at the Canada Border Services Agency upon entry into Canada for a fee of \$25.00.

REGISTRATION

Registration opens at 8:00am on Fri & Sat and at 9:00am on Sunday. All Contestants must be members of the PITA for the current year. Annual membership fee is \$25.00 CAD (first time PITA memberships are \$12.50).

CROSS REGISTRATION

ATA Cross Registration is available at this shoot. \$4 ATA Daily Fee and \$2 BCATA Fee apply.

EARNED YARDAGE

If you earn yardage during the shoot, please check in with the cashier as you may need to move to a different squad.

SHOOT-OFFS

All shoot-offs from Event 1, 2 and 3 will be carried over. Other shoot-offs will follow the last registered event of the day. It is the shooters responsibility to be aware of any shoot off. Contestants who miss their shoot off will forfeit.

GENERAL INFORMATION

ROOKIE OF THE YEAR

All new British Columbia shooters who have not shot any PITA or ATA registered targets until after last year's BCTA Provincial Shoot are eligible to compete for this category.

Eligible contestants must shoot the BC Singles Championships (Ev. 4 & 5) and BC Handicap Championships (Ev. 7) for a total of 300 targets to qualify.

The winner will be awarded a trophy and will be eligible to represent our Province at the Grand Pacific in July 2022 in the 2022 PITA ROOKIE OF THE YEAR competition. In the absence of the winner, the runner up may compete. Travel assistance will be offered to our Provincial representative.

TARGET SETTING

A target setting committee appointed by the Executive Committee will set targets each morning according to PITA rules. Target setting changes will be made during an event only if the targets become illegal. Resetting of targets must be authorized and checked only by a member of the target setting committee. No exceptions.

SPECIAL HIDDEN SCORE

Available on Handicap Events # 2 & 7



One score will then be drawn to determine the Special Hidden Score. Prize money will be split among shooters shooting the same winning score if applicable.

FORD PURSE

Available on Handicap Events # 2 & 7

Ford Purse sequence is 100-25-25-25-50-50. Limit of 3 Ford purses to any shooter. Ties on 25's and 50's will be decided by carry forward and reverse scoring. If a winner is still not decided, the purse will be divided equally among the shooters. Ties on 100 purse will automatically be divided.






