- ❖ All payouts will be by cheque.
- ❖ The Cowichan Valley Trap & Skeet Club will not be responsible for accidents or loss of property.
- ❖ Shells and lunch available at the clubhouse.
- ❖ The Kitchen Staff will not be offering a dinner this year. Management will be happy to recommend dining alternatives that are close to the range.
- ❖ A Calcutta will be held in the club house between events #4 and #5. Special: Junior and sub junior shooters may enter events #4 and #5 for \$13.00 per event plus daily and target fees. They will not be eligible for added money.
- ❖ The Cowichan Valley Trap & Skeet Club reserves the right to change or modify this program. Notices will be posted on club bulletin boards of any changes.
